**Re: Public Information Centre (PIC) on the redevelopment of the former St. Hilda's Church property located at 1258 Rebecca Street in the Town of Oakville**

The Region of Halton has been working to address the need for paramedic services in southwest Oakville. In September 2013, Regional staff held an open house to obtain feedback from residents on the proposed paramedic station at 1258 Rebecca Street. Residents who attended this session highlighted important issues to consider when integrating the facility into the existing neighbourhood. In response to this feedback, Regional staff in consultation with Town of Oakville staff has developed a concept plan for the entire site that responds to valued community feedback and the operational needs of the Regional paramedic services.

The Region is sharing this concept plan with the neighbourhood. You are invited to attend the Public Information Centre to review and discuss the plan to be held as follows:
