# NOTICE OF STUDY COMPLETION CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT STUDY Derry Road (Regional Road 7) Class Environmental Assessment Study Milburough Line (Regional Road 24) to McNiven Road City of Burlington & Town of Milton PR-2598

### Study

Halton Region has completed a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study to address operational deficiencies along Derry Road (Regional Road 7). A number of road improvement alternatives were examined, including structural and drainage deficiencies, cross-sectional requirements, overall traffic operations and issues associated with the stability of the Bronte Creek tributary, west of McNiven Road. The study has been conducted in compliance with Schedule C of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000, amended 2007), which is approved under the Ontario Environmental Assessment Act.

Taking into consideration the comments that were received from the City of Burlington, the Town of Milton, regulatory agencies and the public, Halton Region is recommending a preferred design which includes the reconstruction of Derry Road from Milburough Line westerly to the Bronte Creek tributary, with a rural 2-lane cross-section, partially paved shoulders and new drainage ditches. The preferred design from the Bronte Creek tributary to McNiven Road includes an urban 2-lane cross-section, retaining walls, and paved shoulders with concrete curb and gutter.

### Process

The Environmental Study Report (ESR) has been prepared to document the planning, public consultation and decision making process undertaken for this study. By this Notice, the ESR is being placed on the public record for a 45-day review period in accordance with the requirements of the Municipal Class EA. Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and the receipt of necessary approvals, Halton Region intends to proceed with the detail design and widening of Derry Road as documented in the ESR.
