THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON

BY-LAW NO. 85-16

A BY-LAW TO REPEAL BY-LAW NO. 126-15, AND TO ESTABLISH 2017 WATER RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE PRODUCTION, TREATMENT, STORAGE AND DISTRIBUTION OF WATER IN THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON.

WHEREAS The Regional Municipality of Halton (hereinafter referred to as the Regional Corporation) by subsection 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the Municipal Act, 2001), has the exclusive responsibility for the production, treatment, storage and distribution of water in the Regional area;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 391 of the Municipal Act, 2001, a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it, for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board, and for the use of its property including property under its control:

AND WHEREAS, in response to the Royal Canadian Mint no longer distributing pennies as of February 4, 2013 and pennies being gradually withdrawn from circulation, the Council of the Regional Corporation is desirous of following the Government of Canada's rounding guidelines for cash transactions.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Regional Corporation deems it necessary and advisable to pass a water rates by-law as referenced in By-law No. 131-10, passed on the 24th day of November, 2010 (hereinafter the Waterworks By-law).

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the 2017 rates, fees and charges as specified in Schedules "A", "B", "C" and "D" to this By-law, which are attached hereto and form an integral part hereof, shall be charged by the Regional Corporation on and after the 1st day of January, 2017.
- 2. THAT By-law No. 126-15 is hereby repealed effective the 1st day of January, 2017.

3.	THAT this By-law comes into force on the day it is passed.

SCHEDULE "A" TO BY-LAW NO. 85-16

1.0 Interpretation

- 1.1 This By-Law shall be read in conjunction with the Waterworks By-Law and the Wastewater Fees and Charges By-Law and the words used in this By-law shall have the same meaning as those used in the Waterworks By-Law and the Wastewater Fees and Charges By-Law unless otherwise indicated.
- 1.2 The following definitions shall apply throughout this by-law:
 - (a) "Applicant" means the Owner of lands that require Water Services, or the Owner's authorized agent;
 - (b) "Bulk Water Consumer" means a Consumer who obtains water from a bulk water station and/or hydrant;
 - (c) "Commissioner" means the Commissioner of Public Works for the Regional Corporation or his authorized representative;
 - (d) "Commissioner of Finance" means the Regional Corporation's Commissioner of Finance:
 - (e) "Consumption Block" means incremental volume of water consumed, as set out in Schedule "C";
 - (f) "Deposit" means security for future fees or charges and may be refunded on terms and conditions set out in this Schedule "A";
 - (g) "Permit Application" means an application to connect to the Waterworks System;
 - (h) "Wastewater Fees and Charges By-Law" means the Regional Corporation's by-law establishing fees and charges for the collection, treatment and disposal of wastewater (sewage) as may be passed from time to time:
 - (i) "Waterworks By-law" means the Regional Corporation's Water By-Law No. 131-10, as amended or a successor by-law, as may be passed by Regional Council from time to time.

2.0 Applications for Water Service

- 2.1 Upon Application for water service, the Applicant shall pay connection charges and other applicable fees as set out in Schedule "B".
- 2.2 In the event that a Service pipe exists and, in the opinion of the Commissioner, it is of sufficient capacity and considered structurally sound, the Commissioner may waive any fee or any part thereof, provided the Regional Corporation has no outstanding account with respect to such Service, in the Commissioner's sole discretion.
- 2.3 The Applicant shall supply, install or perform, as may be applicable, all material and excavation as may be required for the service requested, in accordance with Regional Standards.
- 2.4 The Applicant shall pre-pay any fees and charges, as set out in Schedule "B", for all services requested, before the Regional Corporation will issue a connection permit.

3.0 Water Accounts

3.1 The Regional Corporation may require a Consumer to pay a deposit of \$100.00 as security for payment of Residential accounts. The Regional Corporation may require a Consumer to pay a deposit in an amount to be determined by the Commissioner for Commercial or Industrial accounts. The Regional Corporation shall refund the deposit at the time the Consumer closes the account, provided there is no outstanding balance on the account.

4.0 Water Rates, Fees & Charges

- 4.1 Water rates, fees and usage charges set out in Schedules "B" and "C" to this By-Law shall be effective for all accounts rendered by the Regional Corporation or its designate on all Residential, Commercial or Industrial consumption on or after January 1, 2017.
- 4.2 In consideration of receiving Water Service, the Consumer shall pay all fees, charges, surcharges or other amounts as may be set out in Schedules "B" and "C" to this By-Law upon receipt of an invoice for same.
- 4.3 Residential, Industrial and Commercial Consumers shall pay the monthly Water Rates and Usage Charges as set out in Schedule "C".
- 4.4 Usage Charges per cubic meter are applied progressively through the consumption blocks as water consumption increases. In multi-residential premises without individual Water Meters, Usage Charges shall be

- prorated by the number of units in the premises for the purposes of determining the Consumption Block.
- 4.5 The rate card provided for billing information purposes to Consumers of water and wastewater services shall combine the monthly rates and charges applicable under both this By-law and the Wastewater Fees and Charges By-Law, and will be substantially in the form attached as Schedule "D".

5.0 Standby Time

5.1 The Regional Corporation shall refund a deposit for standby time where the actual standby time is less than the estimated standby time for the service requested.

6.0 Bulk Water

6.1 Bulk Water Consumers shall provide to the Regional Corporation a deposit of \$100.00 or two months of annualized estimated usage, as determined by the Commissioner of Finance, in the form of cash, a certified cheque or unconditional, irrevocable letter of credit in a form acceptable to the Commissioner of Finance.

7.0 Overdue Accounts & Administrative Fees

- 7.1 All overdue accounts may be subject to additional administrative fees, interest or other penalties.
- 7.2 Consumers shall pay an administrative fee of \$23.83 for all cheques that are not honoured by the Regional Corporation's bank or are marked "non-sufficient funds".
- 7.3 Consumers who fail to respond to meter maintenance requests from the Regional Corporation or its agent are subject to a penalty of \$179.46, as set out in Schedule "B".
- 7.4 Despite the fees and charges set out in Schedule "B", the Regional Corporation shall not charge a fee for meter testing if the meter is found to be inaccurate to plus or minus one point five percent (1.5%) at not less than ninety five percent (95%) capacity.
