Masks are mandatory in common areas

Under Regional By-law 47-20, non-medical masks or face coverings are mandatory in certain indoor public places. This includes enclosed common areas of apartment or condominium buildings, such as the lobby, elevator, laundry room, meeting rooms or other similar facilities.

All persons aged five (5) years or older entering or remaining in these premises are required to wear a non-medical mask or face covering, which covers the nose, mouth and chin.

Not everyone's situation is the same and exemptions may not be visible. Please **be kind and supportive** to others in the community who may be exempt from wearing a mask.

Please remember that wearing a mask does not replace other important public health measures:



Wash your hands



Stay home when you are sick



Physically distance with those outside your social circle



Physically distance and wear a mask in indoor public places
