About This Project

This notice is to advise you that Britannia Road (Regional Road 6), between Tremaine Road (Regional Road 22) and Bronte Street South/First Line, Wards 3 & 4, in the Town of Milton will be closed starting Monday, October 28, 2019 at 9:00 a.m. The road is expected to reopen on Monday, November 11, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

A detour route will be put in place, to safely accommodate traffic and limit any delays that this closure may cause. Please see detour map below.

This closure is necessary to safely accommodate construction activity as part of Phase 1 of the Britannia Road Corridor Improvement project. On November 11, a temporary bypass-road at Britannia Road and the rail crossing, will be open to motorists, allowing commuters to travel through the corridor during construction of the new rail overpass.

Please be aware that a **Construction Ambassador** has been assigned to this project and can meet with you to address any questions you have about the project or this closure.
