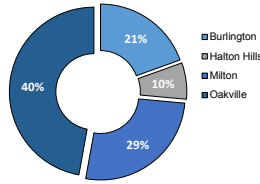

### Distribution of Total Construction Value 2021 <sup>1</sup>



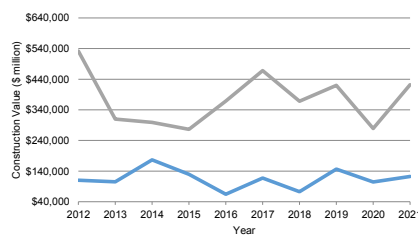
