About This Project

IMPROVEMENTS

To service growth and increasing traffic demands, Halton Region will be opening the new William Halton Parkway East (Reg. Rd. 40), from Sixth Line to Ninth Line (Reg. Rd. 13) on November 21, 2020, Wards 6 & 7, in the Town of Oakville.

This road extension provides safe travel options to motorists, pedestrians, cyclists and first responders. William Halton Parkway East will have:

- a new 4-lane roadway between Sixth Line and Trafalgar Road;
- a new 2-lane roadway between Trafalgar Road and Ninth Line;
- new on-road bike lanes, multi-use pathways and sidewalks;
- new street lighting and landscaping;
- new watermains and wastewater mains;
- a new non-signalized intersection at William Halton Parkway East and Burnhamthorpe Road East;
- a new signalized intersection at William Halton Parkway East and Trafalgar Road; and,
- two new traffic roundabouts, located at the new intersections of William Halton Parkway East at Sixth Line and Ninth Line.
