RE: Non-Reusable Influenza Returns, Vaccine Delivery Schedule & Tdap in pregnancy now publicly funded

QUICK FACTS

- Health care professionals can now return non-reusable influenza vaccines to Halton Region Public Health. Return the vaccine with the Critical Path courier who delivers your routine vaccines.
- The <u>Vaccine Delivery Schedule for April 2022 June 2022</u> has been finalized (see below). The delivery schedule for July and onward will be released mid-June.
- As of April 1, Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis) is now publicly funded and may be routinely offered to pregnant people.

KEY MESSAGES RE. NON-REUSABLE INFLUENZA VACCINE RETURNS

- Non-reusable influenza vaccines includes vaccines that are expired or nearing expiry, deemed no longer viable by Public Health and/or unable to be used due to reduced uptake. Returned vaccines must be whole, un-punctured vials. Partial vials must be disposed in your premises' biomedical waste container.
- Health Care Providers are encouraged to maintain a minimal stock of influenza vaccine in cold chain to accommodate individuals who are seeking influenza immunization between April and August.
- The <u>Non-Reusable Vaccine Return Record</u> must be completed with all returns. Partial vials must be recorded as wastage on this record however, are disposed of as biomedical waste.

KEY MESSAGES RE. TDAP

- The National Advisory Committee on Immunization strongly recommends Tdap vaccination during every pregnancy, regardless of previous Tdap vaccination history to protect the infant from pertussis.
- Infants less than 2 months of age are at the greatest risk of severe pertussis infection and hospitalization. Vaccination in pregnancy is safe and effective at preventing neonatal infection.
- Immunization should ideally be offered at 27-32 weeks of gestation, which is supported by the strongest safety and effectiveness data. Immunization between 13 and 26 weeks of gestation may also be considered in some situations (e.g. pregnancies with an increased risk of preterm delivery).
