Green Cart Acceptable Items



Fruits and vegetables, salads, tofu, nuts and shells



Breads and grains, cereal, pizza, pasta, couscous



Baked goods, cake, cookies, pie and muffins



Meat, fish and shellfish (including bones)



Eggs and egg shells



Dairy products, cheese and yogurt



Tea bags, coffee grounds and filters



Fats, oils, butter, sauces, syrups, peanut butter and jams



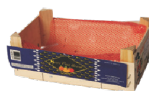
Houseplants, human and pet hair, popsicle sticks

Remember: No plastic, glass, metal, polystyrene foam, stickers, elastics, diapers or pet waste.

Garbage Acceptable Items



Pet waste



Wooden food crates



Diapers and sanitary products



Disposable mop sheets, sanitizing wipes, baby wipes and dryer sheets



Household items e.g. hangers, furnace filter, vacuum bags



Cold cigarette butts and ashes



Light bulbs (not CFLs), ceramics and drinking glasses (wrap in newspaper)

Yard Waste



- Collected every other week on the same day as garbage from April to December (urban areas only).
- Use paper yard waste bags or reusable container (no lid).
- Containers must have yellow yard waste label. Visit halton.ca/waste to order and check acceptable items.
- Containers must not be heavier than 23 kg (50 lbs) or more than 125 litres in capacity.
- Brush must be tied in bundles no larger than 2m x 1m (6ft x 3ft) wide.

What you can recycle



✓ Paper and fibre

- Cardboard boxes (flattened)
- Boxboard (flattened)
- Paper laminate packaging
- Paper laminate containers
- Cartons
- Paper

Empty and free
from food residue.



✓ Plastic and foam

- Hard plastic containers (lids on)
- Plastic packaging and containers
- Tubes
- Small item plastic packaging
- Flexible plastic packaging
- Foam packaging

Empty and free
from food residue.



✓ Metal

- Metal containers
- Aluminum (foils and trays)
- Aerosol containers

Empty and free
from food residue.



✓ Glass

- Glass containers

Lids off.



What's not accepted in recycling

- Alcoholic beverage containers
- Soft or hard covered books/novels
- Aerosols with toxic, corrosive or flammable symbol with the exception of:
 - Cooking oil sprays and products designed for food
 - Hairsprays, cosmetics and products designed to be used on hair/skin
