## Daily Patron List for Restaurants, Bars and other Food and Drink Establishments

**Food or drink establishments** are permitted to open under the *Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020*, provided they follow requirements outlined in Ontario's [Roadmap to Reopen](#).

For every patron who enters an indoor or outdoor dining area in the establishment, other than patrons who temporarily enter the area to place, pick up or pay for a takeout order, establishments are required to:

- record the name, contact information, and attendance details.
- carry out [active screening](#) of every patron who enters an indoor or outdoor dining area in the establishment and record the results;
- maintain the records for a period of at least one month;
- ensure this information is kept secure from unauthorized access at all times; and
- only disclose the records to a medical officer of health or an inspector under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act* on request for a purpose specified in section 2 of that Act or as otherwise required by law.

**\* The business or organization responsible for collecting patron information must protect patron privacy when collecting and storing personal information.**

**All records must be retained for a period of at least one month and if requested by Halton Region Public health must be provided by email or fax.**
