Daily Patron List for Restaurants, Bars and other Food and Drink Establishments

Food or drink establishments are permitted to open under the *Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19) Act, 2020,* provided they follow requirements outlined in Ontario's <u>Roadmap to Reopen</u>.

For every patron who enters an indoor or outdoor dining area in the establishment, other than patrons who temporarily enter the area to place, pick up or pay for a takeout order, establishments are required to:

- i. record the name, contact information, and attendance details.
- ii. carry out <u>active screening</u> of every patron who enters an indoor or outdoor dining area in the establishment and record the results;
- iii. maintain the records for a period of at least one month;
- iv. ensure this information is kept secure from unauthorized access at all times; and
- v. only disclose the records to a medical officer of health or an inspector under the *Health Protection and Promotion Act* on request for a purpose specified in section 2 of that Act or as otherwise required by law.

* The business or organization responsible for collecting patron information <u>must</u> protect patron privacy when collecting and storing personal information.

All records must be retained for a period of at least <u>one month</u> and if requested by Halton Region Public health must be provided by email or fax.
