About This Project

IMPROVEMENTS

Please be advised that Halton Region will be **closing Sixth Line**, Ward 7, in the Town of Oakville and Ward 3, in the Town of Milton **between Burnhamthorpe Road (Reg. Rd. 27) and Lower Base Line from Tuesday, May 19 to Friday, May 29**. The road is expected to re-open (weather permitting) on Saturday, May 30, 2020. The closure is necessary for Halton Region to complete the installation of a wastewater main on Sixth Line as part of the William Halton Parkway (Reg. Rd. 40) project.

For the duration of the closure, motorists travelling on Sixth Line will be detoured along Burnhamthorpe Road (Reg. Rd. 27) and Lower Base Line to Trafalgar Road (Reg. Rd. 3) (see attached map). Motorists should expect delays when travelling through the area.

COVID-19 Update: Projects that provide additional capacity or are essential to the maintenance and repair of Regional infrastructure will continue until further notice. Halton Region staff will be practicing appropriate COVID-19 health and safety measures during this work. Contractors performing work on behalf of the Region have also been encouraged to implement the necessary precautions, procedures and physical distancing measures that meet the guidelines set out by the Province. PLANNING AHEAD

To help you plan ahead for construction activity, please read the project related information below. Wherever possible, mitigation plans will be put in place to minimize disruptions.

Traffic delays: This work may cause traffic delays, lane shifts or lane restrictions. We will make every effort to minimize any potential inconvenience.

Driveway access: Direct access to your driveway may be restricted for short periods of time. We will provide advance notice of any planned restrictions.

Dust and mud: There may be increased levels of dust and mud near the work site. The contractor is required to manage these impacts.
