About This Project

Please be advised that Halton Region will be closing Walkers Line between Jordan Avenue/Millcroft Park Drive and Upper Middle Road (Reg. Rd. 38) from **Friday October 16, 2020 at 9:00 p.m. to Saturday October 17, 2020 at 9:00 a.m.**, as part of the resurfacing of Upper Middle Road from Guelph Line (Reg. Rd. 1) to Country Club Drive/Itabashi Way, Wards 4 and 6 in the City of Burlington.

Southbound traffic on Walkers Line approaching Jordan Avenue/Millcroft Park Drive will be detoured along Jordan Avenue and Cleaver Avenue, ([see attached map](#)). Northbound traffic will be able to turn right or left onto Upper Middle Road, and have access to the above-noted detour to carry-on north of Upper Middle Road.

Emergency vehicle access and local access will be maintained at all times. Every effort will be made to complete the construction work as quickly as possible to lessen the impact of the road closure.
