



School- Based Vaccine Administration Reporting Form

School-based vaccines are **HPV, Hepatitis B and Men-C-ACYW** vaccines, which are administered as part of Ontario's **routine** publicly funded immunization program. These vaccines are typically administered by Public Health through school clinics but can also be given by health care professionals in the community.

Health care professionals are asked to use this form to report any school-based vaccines that they administer to Public Health. This helps to prevent duplicate immunizations if a student attends a school clinic after receiving a school-based vaccine from another health care professional. Parents or guardians should still be advised to report immunizations by visiting halton.ca/immunize.
