The next steps include completing technical studies based on the preliminary preferred design to confirm impacts and preliminary mitigation measures. Some of these studies include stormwater and drainage, natural environment and noise studies. The preliminary preferred design will be further refined based on the outcome of the technical studies.

Preliminary mitigation measures and commitments to future work will be recommended in the Environmental Study Report. These measures will be based on Halton Region policies, standards and best practices as well as regulatory agency requirements and conditions of approval.

Preliminary mitigation measures will be refined during the future detailed design phase.

#### Slide 43: Next Steps in the MCEA Study

Following this PIC, the Project Team will:

- Review and consider feedback from agencies, stakeholders, Indigenous Communities, and the public.
- Prepare the Environmental Study Report, which documents the study decision making process and recommendations.
- Publish the Notice of Completion and commence the 30-day Environmental Study Report review period.
