- All waste events, including the Fall Compost Giveaway and Special Waste Drop-off Days, are cancelled for 2020.

HWMS visitor information

- For health and safety reasons, Container Station Attendants are not permitted to assist customers with the unloading of materials. Pre-arrange assistance to help unload heavy material, if needed.
- Secure all open loads with a tarp or rope.
- Customers are expected to sort their loads by material type. Pre-sort loads prior to delivery to the HWMS for quick and easy unloading.
- Remove all fluids (gas, oil, etc.) from gas powered equipment such as lawnmowers.
- Oil drums and tanks must be empty and cut in half.
- Concrete/asphalt with rebar or wire mesh cannot be accepted for recycling. These items are accepted as garbage at the tipping fee of \$170/tonne.
- Customers dropping off clean fill, woodchips, bricks, rubble or concrete, material must be removed from bags or containers prior to disposal.

Reuse Depot

Halton residents can drop off items that are in good condition and fit for resale at the Reuse Depot, located within the HWMS, free of charge.

Blue Boxes and Green Carts


If necessary, residents can pick up one Blue Box or Green Cart at the HWMS, but will be required to pick up their own container and carry it to their vehicle.
