The next steps in the Study include:

- Updating the technical studies, such as the stormwater and drainage, transportation, natural environment based on preliminary preferred design to identify impacts;
- Recommending preliminary mitigation measures in the Environmental Study Report(s) along with commitments for future work;
 - Preliminary mitigation measures will be based on Halton Region policies, standards and best practices, as well as regulatory agency requirements and conditions of approval.
 - These measures will be refined during the future detailed design phase.

Slide 3: Next Steps in the MCEA Study

Following this Public Information Centre, the Project Team will:

- Review and consider feedback from agencies, stakeholders, Indigenous Communities, and the public;
- Prepare the Environmental Study Report(s) to document the decision-making process and commitments to detailed design; and
- Publish the Notice of Completion and commence the 30-day Environmental Study Report review period.
