RE: Halton Region Public Health Offering March Break Community Immunization Clinics

QUICK FACTS

- Halton Region Public Health is offering community immunization clinics for students in grades 9 through 12, weekdays from **Monday, March 13** to **Friday, March 24, 2023**.
- Eligible students will be offered the following vaccines:

Usually given in grade seven school-based clinics.

Vaccines Available at March Break Clinics
Human Papillomavirus – HPV
Hepatitis B – HB
Meningococcal Conjugate-ACYW-135
Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis, Polio – Tdap-IPV
Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis – Tdap
Inactivated Poliomyelitis – IPV
Measles, Mumps, Rubella – MMR

Vaccines required for school attendance under the *Immunization* of *School Pupils Act* (ISPA).

KEY MESSAGES FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS

- The Ministry of Health has extended eligibility for school-based vaccines to August 31, 2023.
- If you have eligible students in your practice, and would like them to attend a community immunization clinic, please contact them and encourage that they book an appointment at Halton.ca/immunize.
- If you have ordered and received any of the above vaccines for individual patients (through special order process), have them receive their immunizations at your practice. Please also remind them to report any doses administered by visiting Halton.ca/immunize.
- Special orders for school-based vaccines will continue to be processed as usual. Refer to <u>Vaccine Delivery</u> Schedule.

KEY MESSAGES FOR PATIENTS

- Parents/guardians are responsible for updating their child's online immunization record every time they receive vaccines from their healthcare provider.
- Parents/guardians can view and update online immunization records at Halton.ca/immunize.
- Parents/guardians can also visit <u>Halton.ca/immunize</u> to book an appointment at a community immunization clinic.
