About This Project

Halton Region is making improvements to Trafalgar Road (Regional Road 3) from Leighland Ave to north of Hays Blvd, Wards 5 & 6 in the Town of Oakville. This project will address future traffic demands and provide safe travel options for motorists, pedestrians and cyclists.

To safely accommodate construction for road widening, the sidewalk along the west side of Trafalgar Road will be closed between Leighland Avenue and North of Hays Boulevard (see page 2 of this notice for map). Details of this sidewalk closure are as follows:

Notice of Sidewalk Closure—St. Josephs Ukrainian Church

Closure: Sidewalk along the west side of Trafalgar Road.

Limits: From Leighland Ave to North of Hays Blvd, as shown on **page 2 of this notice**.

Timing: January 2020 to December 2020.

Detour Route: For pedestrian access to Trafalgar Road, please use the intersection at River Oaks Blvd and Trafalgar Road to cross street and use east sidewalk. The pedestrian detour route can be found on **page 3 of this notice**.

All Oakville Transit and GO Transit bus stops along the west side of Trafalgar Road are being relocated to the nearest available intersection. These will remain accessible throughout this phase of construction.

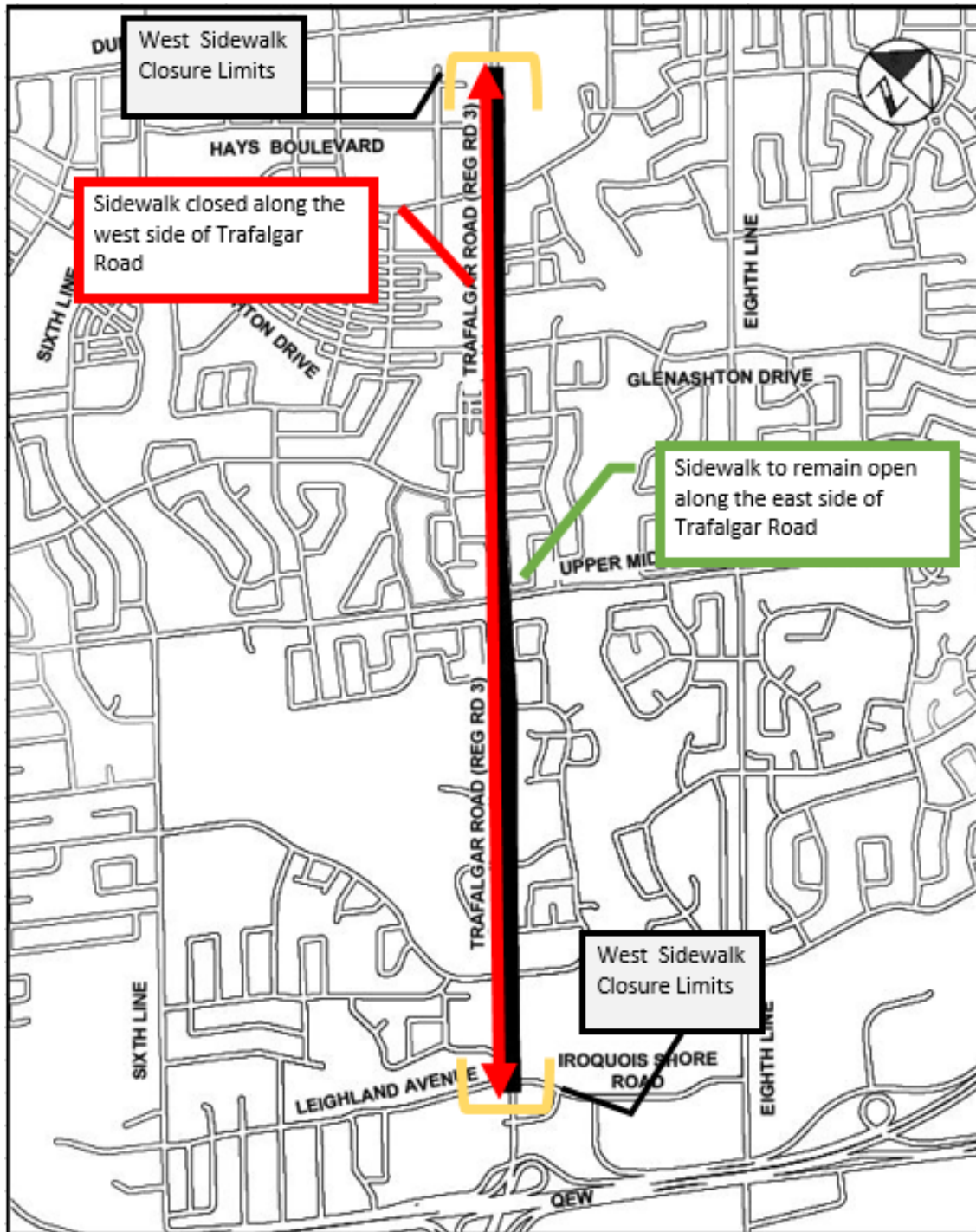

LIMITS OF TRAFALGAR ROAD SIDEWALK CLOSURE

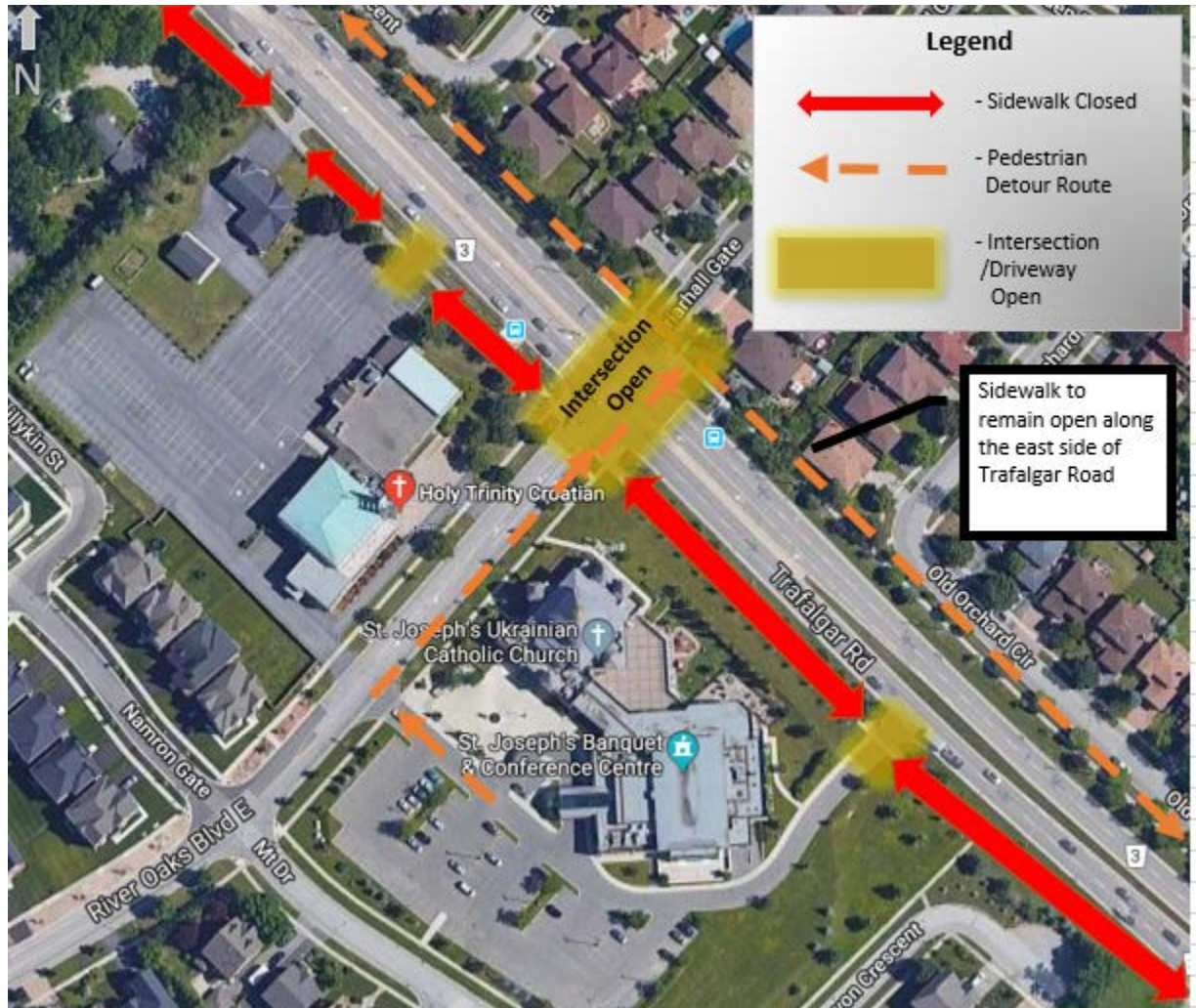
