We're making progress!

We've continued work on the improvements to Trafalgar Road and are pleased to share an update on our progress since we last communicated to you in December.

More than 60,000 commuters rely on this corridor every day and these improvements are vital to keeping the road safe and motorists, cyclists, pedestrians and transit users moving.

Construction work is happening in three phases during the project:



Phase 1 - Currently under construction (began December 2019)

Temporary traffic signals have been installed and traffic lanes have shifted to the **east side** of the corridor. Work is underway on the west side of Trafalgar Road, including:

- road widening;
- watermain installation;
- stormwater management infrastructure (see Image 1);
- sidewalk and curbs;
- pedestrian bridge north of Leighland Avenue (see Image 2);
- landscaping;
- streetlighting; and
- bike lanes.

Phase 2 - Begins late 2020

Traffic lanes will shift to the **west side** of the corridor to facilitate work on the east side of Trafalgar Road.

Phase 3 - Begins mid-2021

Traffic lanes will shift to the east and west sides of the corridor to facilitate work along the **centre** of Trafalgar Road. This work will start once Phase 1 and 2 are complete.

Anticipated project completion - December 2021

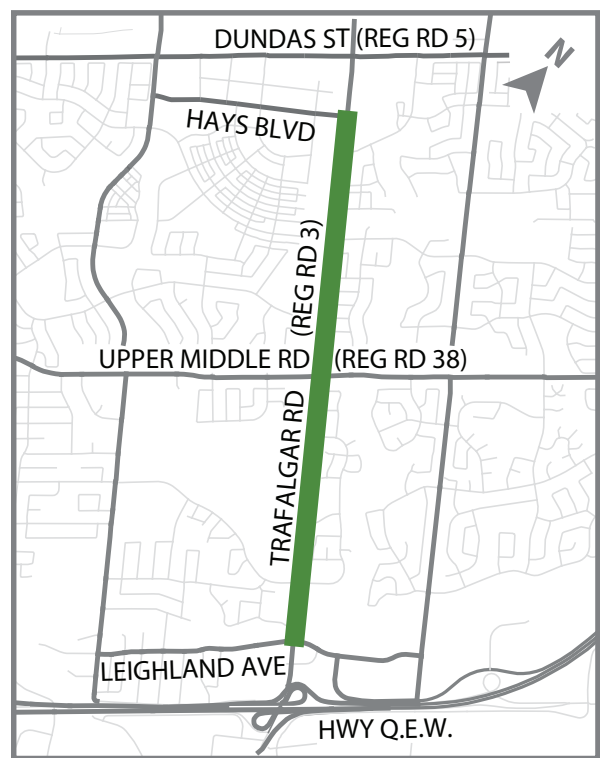

Planning ahead for construction impacts

Trafalgar Road is one of the busiest corridors in the region and we understand that construction may cause some delays for daily road users. Here are some ways that we are keeping residents informed during construction:

- Electronic signs enabled by Bluetooth technology are posted throughout the Trafalgar corridor (at Leighland Avenue, Upper Middle Road and Dundas Street) to provide commuters with up-to-date travel times to help plan your commute.
- Some work may be required at night or on weekends to safely complete technically challenging construction operations and minimize impacts during peak travel periods. Night work will be an occasional occurrence. Information will be posted on the Trafalgar webpage and social media.
- Residents who may be impacted by any waste, water supply or other construction-related disruptions will receive letters in advance.
- As a reminder, two lanes of traffic in each direction will be open during peak travel hours. The Region will share further updates on Phase 2 and Phase 3 lane shifts in the future.
