Construction begins August 2026

About This Project

Halton Region is preparing to begin construction of a new three-storey residential building at 363 Margaret Drive, Oakville, that will provide 13 family apartment units as part of a supportive and assisted housing initiative. The development will welcome applicants from the Halton Access to Community Housing (HATCH) waitlist, helping to address the growing need for supportive housing options for families in Halton Region. We will make every effort to complete the work as quickly as possible to minimize any potential impacts.

PLANNING AHEAD

To help you plan for construction, please read the project-related information below. Wherever possible, steps are taken to reduce disruptions.

Dust and mud: There may be increased levels of dust and mud near the work site. The contractor will manage these impacts.

Erosion and sediment controls: We will install erosion and sediment control measures for the duration of the project, including tree protection fence and perimeter fencing with heavy-duty silt fabric.

Noise: You may experience some noise because of this Regional improvement. We will schedule work in accordance with local noise by-laws and make every effort to minimize any disruption or inconvenience to the surrounding community.

Truck traffic: You will notice occasional increases in truck traffic around the ongoing work. Please be aware and use extra caution while driving.
