RE: Returning Non-Reusable Influenza Vaccines

## **QUICK FACTS**

- Health care professionals can now return non-reusable influenza vaccines to Halton Region Public Health.
- Return the vaccine with the Critical Path courier who delivers your vaccines.
- If you do not use Critical Path to receive your vaccine deliveries, you can return non-reusable influenza vaccines to 1151 Bronte Road in Oakville between 8:30 am and 3:00 pm, Monday Friday.

## KEY MESSAGES RE. NON-REUSABLE INFLUENZA VACCINE RETURNS

- Non-reusable influenza vaccines include vaccines that are expired or nearing expiry, deemed no longer viable by Public Health and/or unable to be used due to reduced uptake.
- Returned vaccines must be whole, unpunctured vials. Partial vials must be disposed in your premises' biomedical waste container.
- Health care professionals are encouraged to maintain a minimal stock of influenza vaccine in cold chain to accommodate individuals who are seeking influenza immunization between April and August.
- Wasted vaccines must be bagged. The bag must be labelled "WASTE" and include your premises' holding point code.
- The <u>Non-Reusable Vaccine Return Record</u> must be completed with all returns. Partial vials must be recorded as wastage on this record, but they must be disposed of in your premises' biomedical waste container.
