QUICK FACTS

- On Friday, April 30, residents 16 years of age and older living in the Milton L9E postal code area can book a COVID-19 vaccination appointment at halton.ca/COVIDvaccines.
- To be eligible, residents must have had their 16th birthday on or before the date of the first dose appointment.
- The Milton L9E postal code is a designated 'hot spot' in Phase 2 of the <u>Province's prioritization plan</u> due to historical and ongoing high rates of COVID-19.
- Halton Region Public Health does not have the authority to grant exceptions to eligibility.
- Individuals part of other <u>eligible groups</u> that are 16 and 17 years old can also get vaccinated and can book online.
 - Appointments for this age group will continue to be limited to our hospital clinic locations to ensure they
 receive the Pfizer vaccine, which is the only vaccine approved for use in individuals 16 and 17 years of
 age.
