

THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON

BY-LAW NO. 49-25

A by-law to establish 2026 wastewater fees and charges for the collection and disposal of wastewater (sewage) in the Regional Municipality of Halton and to repeal By-law No. 55-24.

WHEREAS The Regional Municipality of Halton (hereinafter referred to as the Regional Corporation) by subsection 11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the *Municipal Act, 2001*), has the exclusive responsibility for the collection of sanitary sewage and sewage treatment in the Regional area;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 391 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it, for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board, and for the use of its property including property under its control;

AND WHEREAS all Wastewater Surcharge Rates set out in Schedule "C" are first calculated on the basis of a surcharge on the rates set out in the Water Rates By-law and are then converted to a basic charge based on the size of the water meter of the customer concerned and to a charge per meter of usage, all for the easier reference and calculation by the consumer;

AND WHEREAS, in response to the Royal Canadian Mint no longer distributing pennies as of February 4, 2013 and pennies being gradually withdrawn from circulation, the Council of the Regional Corporation is desirous of following the Government of Canada's rounding guidelines for cash transactions;

AND WHEREAS the Regional Corporation deems it necessary and advisable to pass a wastewater rates by-law as referenced in By-law No. 71-19, passed on the 10th day of July, 2019 (hereinafter the Waterworks By-law).

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE REGIONAL MUNICIPALITY OF HALTON HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the 2026 rates, fees and charges as specified in Schedules "A", "B", "C" and "D" to this By-law, which are attached hereto and form an integral part hereof, shall be charged by the Regional Corporation on and after the 1st day of January, 2026.

2. THAT By-law No. 55-24 is hereby repealed effective the 1st day of January, 2026.
3. THAT this By-law comes into force and effect on the 1st day of January, 2026.

SCHEDULE “A” TO BY-LAW NO. 49-25

1.0 Interpretation

- 1.1. This By-law shall be read in conjunction with the Waterworks By-law, the Water Fees and Charges By-law and the words used in this By-law shall have the same meaning as those in the Waterworks By-law and the Water Fees and Charges By-law unless otherwise indicated.
- 1.2. The following definitions shall apply throughout this by-law:
- (a) “Audit Search Fee” means a fee to determine whether there are any recorded illegal wastewater discharges at a Property;
 - (b) “Commissioner” means the Commissioner of Public Works for the Regional Corporation or his authorized representative;
 - (c) “Commissioner of Finance” means the Regional Corporation’s Commissioner of Finance and Regional Treasurer;
 - (d) “Permit Application” means an application to connect to the Wastewater System;
 - (e) “Water Fees and Charges By-law” means the Regional Corporation’s by-law establishing fees and charges for the production, treatment, storage and distribution of water as may be passed from time to time;
 - (f) “Waterworks By-law” means the Regional Corporation’s Water By-law No. 71-19, as amended or its successor by-law.

2.0 Applications for Wastewater Service

- 2.1. Upon application for wastewater service or water and wastewater services, the Applicant shall pay a permit fee in the amount as set out in Schedule “B”.
- 2.2. The Applicant shall supply, install or perform, as may be applicable, all material and excavation as may be required for the service requested, in accordance with the Regional Standards.

3.0 Wastewater Fees & Charges

- 3.1. Wastewater rates, fees, surcharges and Usage Charges set out in Schedule “C” to this By-law shall be effective for all accounts rendered by the Regional Corporation or its designate for all Residential, Industrial, Commercial or Institutional consumption on or after January 1st, 2026.
- 3.2. In consideration of receiving Wastewater Service, the Consumer shall pay all rates, fees, charges, surcharges or other amounts as may be set out in Schedules “B” and “C” to this By-law upon receipt of an invoice for same.
- 3.3. Residential, Industrial, Commercial and Institutional Consumers shall pay the monthly Wastewater Surcharge and Usage Charge as set out in Schedule “C”.
- 3.4. The rate card provided for billing information purposes to Consumers of water and wastewater services shall combine the monthly rates and charges applicable under both this by-law and the Water Fees and Charges By-law and will be substantially in the form attached as Schedule “D”.
- 3.5. In the event that a connection provides Wastewater Service for both Residential, Industrial, Commercial or Institutional use, the Customer shall pay the Industrial, Commercial and Institutional Wastewater rates, fees and surcharges.

4.0 Surcharge Abatement

- 4.1. Industrial, Commercial or Institutional Consumers may be entitled to a percentage discount from the wastewater surcharge pursuant to Report FN-08-93. Industrial, Commercial or Institutional Consumers who wish to apply for the abatement shall pay an application fee as set out in Schedule “B”.

5.0 Standby Time

- 5.1. The Regional Corporation shall refund a deposit for standby time where the actual standby time is less than the estimated standby time for the service requested.

6.0 Sampling Fees

- 6.1. Upon request for wastewater sampling and the payment of the fee or charge identified in Schedule “B”, the Regional Corporation shall obtain a 24-hour composite wastewater sample in order to assess the quality of wastewater. The

Regional Corporation reserves the right to charge the Consumer additional fees for further analysis, including laboratory analysis by an external provider, where the Commissioner determines that such analysis is required.

7.0 Overdue Accounts & Administrative Fees

- 7.1. All overdue accounts may be subject to additional administrative fees, interest or other penalties.
- 7.2. Consumers shall pay an administrative fee of \$29.75 for all cheques that are not honoured by the Regional Corporation's bank or are marked "non-sufficient funds".
