DEVELOPMENT CHARGE BY-LAW

In February 2021, Halton Region began a consultation process for the 2022 development charges update. A Background Study has been prepared to propose a by-law that will replace the Region's existing residential and non-residential water, wastewater (Built Boundary and Greenfield Areas), roads and general services development charges in By-law No. 36-17.

The "2022 Halton Development Charges Background Study" for the Region's Development Charges By-law was made available to the public on **Wednesday December 15, 2021,** and can be obtained through the Office of the Regional Clerk at 1151 Bronte Road, Oakville, Ontario, L6M 3L1.
