Updates to the Halton Online Prenatal Education Program

We have a new online prenatal program where expectant and new parents can learn about healthy pregnancy, labour and birth, breastfeeding and newborn care right from their computer or mobile device. If your patients require extra in-person support during pregnancy or postpartum, they can register for the Healthy Babies Healthy Children and the Halton Prenatal Nutrition Programs through **halton.ca** or by calling 311.



Immunization update for 2018-19 school year

Working together, we can ensure children are compliant with the provincial *Immunization of School Pupils Act* (ISPA) and avoid school suspension. This year, we will be notifying **all high school** (born between 2001-2004) **and grade 3 students** (born in 2010) to update their records with the Health Department to avoid school suspension in early 2019.
