RE: Suspension of Routine and Special Vaccine Orders

### **QUICK FACTS**

- Due to the alarming rate of COVID-19 cases from the Omicron variant, Public Health and Critical Path Courier need to focus efforts on delivering COVID-19 vaccines to Health Care Providers, clinics and other locations.
- As a result, ordering and delivery of routine and special vaccines (HB, Men-C-ACYW135 and HPV-9) is suspended for the month of January.
- COVID-19 vaccine delivery will continue as per normal delivery schedule.
- Public Health understands that this change may cause some inconvenience to patients and Health Care Providers and we apologize for the inconvenience.

#### **KEY MESSAGES FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS**

- Vaccine pick-ups will **not** be permitted at Halton Regional Centre.
- There are a few exceptions to high-risk vaccines that will be considered on an individual basis by contacting 311.
- Orders placed prior to January 4<sup>th</sup>, will remain in queue for processing and will be delivered in February as outlined in the <u>January—April 2022 Vaccine Delivery Schedule</u>.
- Public Health continues to accept premises to the <u>COVID-19 Vaccine Onboarding Program</u> if criteria is met.

#### **KEY MESSAGES FOR PATIENTS**

- Cases of the Omicron variant have increased at an alarming rate and vaccination efforts must focus on COVID-19.
- Routine and special vaccines can be administered in February. There is no cause to restart an immunization series.
